



TWO CARD Poker

\$10 buys you into the game.

[Rules limit you to one purchase only.]



PULL TWO cards from the deck. The Chilly Willy Girl will put your initial on your cards and return the cards to you.

During lunch the Chilly Willy Girls will pull three cards and post the cards on the cork board at front of the room.

If you can put a “best hand” together with the two cards with your initials and the cards on the cork board ... You win the \$250 dollars!! It is that easy. [If there is a tie ... we will flip a coin – heads or tails.]

The prize - - \$250 for one lucky player!

Rank of Poker Hands. As in all games of chance the hands in poker are ranked according to their rarity. The rarer the hand is the more valuable hand. Starting with the highest (rarest) possible hand:

1. **Five of a Kind.** We are using several decks. This could happen.
2. **Royal Flush.** This is the best possible hand in standard five-card poker. Ace, King, Queen, Jack and 10, all of the same suit. (Suite ranking - strongest: spades, diamonds, clubs and hearts.)
3. **Straight Flush** Any five-card sequence in the same suit (e.g.: 8, 9, 10, Jack and Queen of clubs; or 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of diamonds).
4. **Four of a Kind** All four cards of the same value (e.g.: 8, 8, 8, 8; etc).
5. Full House
6. Flush
7. Straight - Five Cards in Sequence
8. Three of a Kind
9. Two Pair
10. One Pair
11. Highest Card
